Description:

The zoological exhibition Noah's Ark introduces visitors to the New Building of the National Museum to the fascinating world of animals that inhabit or have inhabited our planet. The exhibition takes visitors through gorges and mountain peaks, across the islands of the Caribbean or Madagascar, through the mysterious underwater world, northern pastures and other corners of our planet inhabited or inhabited by various creatures.

Technical description:

Helvar lighting control was used to make the exhibits more attractive and to attract attention. The reflector lighting used, mounted on rails, is divided into 88 separate phase-dimmed circuits. RGB reflectors positioned on the sides create a coloured light spectrum add impressively to the overall impression. The illumination of the display case lighting is designed with LED strips, which light up in front of the visitors and switch off after leaving the display case area. The user visualization allows

comfortable control of the entire exposition.
